Lake Link

South Shore visitors and residents are getting a new way to get around with the launch of Lake Link, a microtransit shuttle system. The service will offer free rides in a zone including the casino corridor in Stateline, Nev., and Al Tahoe Boulevard and Pioneer Trail in South Lake Tahoe, Calif. The on-demand system will be accessed and scheduled through the Lake Link app and operate 365 days per year 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and until 10 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays in summer and winter. Funding for the shuttles is a collaboration of public and private partnerships. (www.tahoelakelink.com) "Lake Link is a new tool to help alleviate congestion in our tourist core and at some of the most popular recreation access points," said Raymond Suarez, Lake Link prográm manager. "It will connect visitors and residents to trails, beaches, entertainment, and nightlife, and be a resource for general commuters. This service will prove convenient, and by reducing vehicle traffic and getting more people to use public transit, we'll improve our environment and help protect the lake."


The shuttles carry 9-12 passengers and are equipped with bike and ski racks for the transportation of gear while riders are allowed to bring anything that can fit underneath the seat or in their lap. The fleet includes wheelchair-accessible shuttles. and riders can indicate on the app if they need certain accommodations. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult to ride. Only service animals are allowed on the vehicles.

MS Dixie

The M.S. Dixie II was built in Wisconsin, shipped in pieces (yes, it was a bit of a squeak through the Cave Rock tunnel just a few miles away from her home port) and launched in 1994. While she does get power from her paddles, the M.S. Dixie II also has propellers, which helps her churn a faster pace towards Emerald Bay and back and allows her to finish up to five cruises in a day, carrying over 500 passengers at full capacity. The captain will captivate you with some fun facts and local color stories on the trip west to the mouth of the Bay and then the real oohs and aahs from the passengers take over for the narration as the truly Emerald waters of the Bay cause you to pause breathing and the site of Vikingsholm Castle take you back to what it might be like in 1920 when Mrs. Lora Josephine Knight dynamited the rocks above to build a road that would allow her to complete what is considered one of the best examples of Scandinavian architecture in North America.







<u>Biking</u>

The Pope-Baldwin Bike Path or Camp Richardson Bike Path is one of the most popular paved trails in the scenic Lake Tahoe area, as it winds through pine forest not far from the lakeshore. The trail parallels State Route 89 (Emerald Bay Road) for more than 3 miles, offering access to a number of local historic and recreational amenities.

The path also passes through the grounds of the historic Camp Richardson Resort, while the Tallac Historic Site, featuring three restored estates from the early 1900s, is a short trip up Heritage Way from the trail. Stop in at the Lake Tahoe (Taylor Creek) Visitor Center for more information on the local history and recreational opportunities or to stroll one of their many nature trails.

From the trail's eastern end, cyclists can continue on low-stress Eloise Avenue and Dunlap Drive to reach retail centers along SR 89 (Emerald Bay Road) and US 50 (Lake Tahoe Boulevard) in South Lake Tahoe.

Parking and Trail Access:

Parking for the Pope-Baldwin Bike Path is available at the Lake Tahoe (Taylor Creek) Visitor Center on SR 89 (Emerald Bay Road) west of South Lake Tahoe. Additional parking can be found at Baldwin Beach and Pope Beach, but parking fees apply.



Bike and Gear Rentals





Flatstick Pub


